Equitable Partnerships: what does it mean for R4D actors?



1- Shared Power and Decision-Making

All voices heard and valued
Equal ability to influence outcomes
Transparency in processes and decision-making, including budget allocation



2- Reciprocity and Mutual Benefit

Acknowledgment of contributions of each actorFair distribution of benefits, risks and responsibilities

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3- Inclusivity and Social Justice

Consideration of differing needs and constraints
A commitment to shared values, while acknowledging that these may not be universal
Amplifying least privileged voices



4-Co-Construction and Collaboration

- Participatory project design
 Think long-term collaboration, beyond project logic
- Facilitate knowledge-sharing and capacity-building
 Adapt approaches to remain equitable in changing contexts



5- Ethics and Reflexivity

•Questioning power dynamics and structural imbalances
